At the meeting it was agreed that Parish Councils should consider this proposal for varied flight paths and report back to HWCAAG. There was much discussion on the width of the proposed bands and how activity within the slots would be measured to ensure an equitable share.

It was **RESOLVED** to recommend to Full Council that the proposal is agreed in principle.
