

Local Government for Langton Green, Speldhurst, Ashurst and Old Groombridge

Minutes of a Planning Committee Meeting held on Monday 23rd November 2015 at 7.30pm in the Parish Council Office, Langton Green Recreation Ground

MEMBERS PRESENT: Cllrs Mrs Hull, Mrs Lyle, Allen, Turner, Mercieca In the absence of Cllr Mrs Horne, Cllr Turner (Vice Chairman) acted as Chairman.

MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC PRESENT: There was one member of the public present, Mr Phil Cooper, in connection with 15/508917/FULL 'The Orchard' in Ferbies, Speldhurst.

- **1.** To enquire if anyone present intends to film, photograph and/or record the meeting: No-one present intended to film, photograph and/or record the meeting.
- 2. To receive and approve apologies and reason for absence: Cllr Mrs Jeffries and Cllr Mrs Horne (both prior engagement)
- **3.** Disclosure of Pecuniary or Non-Pecuniary Interests: Mrs M Flemington declared an interest in the two Bradleys applications. (14/501167/FULL and 14/501170LBC)
- 4. Declarations of Lobbying: There were none.
- 5. Minutes: RESOLVED that the minutes of the Planning Committee meeting held on 26th October 2015 be approved as a correct record and signed by the Chairman.

6. Matters Arising:

Paperless planning and e-consultation – there was nothing to report. Trees – there was nothing to report. Public Open Session: There was one member of the public present in connection with 15/508917/FULL – The Orchard, Ferbies, Speldhurst. It was agreed to bring this application forward on the agenda.

Mr Cooper distributed a written statement detailing his comments on the application and photographs of the front and rear elevations. Mr Cooper read his statement .

Mrs Hull noted the Council was pleased Mr Cooper had consulted his neighbours. Following a neighbour's concern that he didn't want a two storey extension so close to the boundary, Mr Cooper reduced the application to a single storey extension. The roof design has also been amended to accommodate neighbour's concerns.

The Committee discussed the application and **RESOLVED** to make the following decision:

8. Planning appeals:

The planning appeal in respect of 15/502971/LBC – Lower Church Farmhouse, Speldhurst Hill, Speldhurst following refusal by TWBC for an application for listed building consent to restore front door into the property, requiring removal of window and new front door in oak to the hallway of the house is ongoing.

The planning appeal in respect of 15/502582 – Little Stonewall Oast, Speldhurst Road, Langton Green following refusal by TWB for an application for ancillary residential use to oast, new first floor and fenestration changes is ongoing.

The planning appeal in respect of 14/506729 - Pokehill Farm, South Farm Lane, Langton Green following refusal by TWBC for an application for Conversion of a redundant stable building to two holiday lets with small extension is ongoing.

Comments: This development proposal would ensure the preservation of the historic mill for the future. We note that the flood risk has been assessed. We would ask the Planning Officer to ensure there is no encroachment on the Green Belt.
