Minutes of a Planning Committee Meeting held in the Parish Council Office, Langton Green Recreation Ground on Tuesday 7th May 2013 at 7.30pm

5. Matters Arising:

Neighbourhood Planning: Cllr Turner reported that the decision has been made to prepare a Village Design Statement rather than a Neighbourhood Plan. The next Working Group meeting is on 29th May. **Planning Appeals:** Planning Appeals are on-going in respect of The Old Saw Mill, Langton Road, Speldhurst and Hollonds Farm, Langton Green. The Planning Appeal in respect of 32 Upper Profit, Langton Green has been withdrawn as the applicant has now received planning consent for a revised application. Cllr Mrs Soyke reported that there has been no progress in respect of Jessups Farm, Ashurst – **the Assistant Clerk to contact TWBC.**

Tunbridge Wells pre-application advice service: The Assistant Clerk to circulate the document.

Speldhurst Conservation Area: The Assistant Clerk confirmed that the Conservation Area extension had been adopted and circulated the map to show this.

Review of Terms of Reference: These need to be reviewed and any amendments agreed at the next Planning Committee meeting so they can be put to the July Full Council meeting for approval.

Cllr Mrs Hull enquired whether there is a policy for work to large trees that are not subject to a TPO. **The Assistant Clerk to investigate.**

Following Cllr Mrs Hull's comments regarding TPOs in the Parish, Cllr Langridge suggested that a substantial oak tree in Gipps Cross Lane be investigated, with the permission of the owner, as to whether it has a TPO on it. When the answer is known, the Committee will decide on a course of action for this tree and any others that may be considered important to protect.

Cllr Turner reported neighbour's concerns that a property in Hither Chantlers is constructing a front boundary which is not in accordance with the covenant for open frontages in Hither Chantlers. They should contact TWBC planning.
