Minutes of a Planning Committee Meeting held in the Parish Council Office, Langton Green Recreation Ground, on Tuesday 8th April 2014 at 7.30pm

MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC PRESENT: There were no members of the public present

- 1. Apologies and Reasons for Absence: There were none.
- 2. Declarations of Interest: There were none
- 3. Declarations of Lobbying: There were none
- **4. Minutes: RESOLVED** that the minutes of the Planning Committee meeting held on **10th March 2014** were approved and signed as a true record.
- 5. Matters Arising:

Cheyne House, Langton Road, Langton Green – Cllr Langridge reported that the neighbour is unhappy with the planning decision and has taken this up with TWBC and Borough Cllr Stanyer. Trees – there was nothing to report.

7. Planning appeals – update situation

30 Holmewood Ridge, Langton Green – the appeal has not been determined yet.
Northfield Lodge, Langton Green – the appeal has not been determined yet.
4 Newlands, Langton Green – the appeal has not been determined yet.
Treetops (land adjacent to), Stonewall Park Road, Langton Green – this appeal has been lodged since the last meeting. The Planning comments made by this Committee to TWBC and the reasons for

refusal of the application by TWBC were discussed and it was **RESOLVED** to make the following comments to the Planning Inspectorate:

- We note from Tunbridge Wells Borough Council Local Development Framework Site Allocations DPD Appendix 1: Villages and Rural Areas that the majority of the site is designated as an Area of Landscape Importance EN22 and lies within a Conservation Area. We note from the Tunbridge Wells Borough Council decision notice refusing the planning application that the proposal would be in contravention of EN1 and EN5 as well as EN22.
- Development of this site would be contrary to Core Policy 4: Environment and Core Policy 14: Development in villages and surrounding areas.
- There would also be a significantly adverse impact on the biodiversity and ecology of the Conservation Area. A colony of great crested newts was discovered 220 metres away from the quarry during the Langton Green Primary School expansion planning application (KCC planning application ref: TW/14/154)

Location: 14 Upper Profit, Langton Green, Royal Tunbridge Wells Proposal: Rear extension

Decision: Remain neutral - leave to Planning Officer

TW/14/00616/HOUSE/EA1

Location: 2 Great Footway, Langton Green, Royal Tunbridge Wells Proposal: Two storey side extension, single storey rear extension and internal alteration

Decision: Remain neutral – leave to Planning Officer

TW/14/00651/HOUSE/JS5

Location: 11 Langholm Road, Langton Green, Royal Tunbridge Wells Proposal: Retrospective: Removal of a crumbling wall and dead hedge and erect a 1.82 metre (72 inch) high fence within the boundaries of the property

Decision: Recommend refusal

Comments: The height and aesthetic impact of the fence is not in keeping with the street scene. The fence abuts the pavement and public footpath creating a potential hazard to pedestrians with cars reversing unsighted out of the drive. This is a well-used footpath for parents and children walking between the village and the primary school. Concern that this could create a precedent.

Decision: Recommend refusal

Comments: The height and aesthetic impact of the fence is not in keeping with the street scene. The visual impact of this fence alters the character of the street scene. Concern that this could create a precedent.

Location: The Cottage, Groombridge Hill, Groombridge, Royal Tunbridge Wells Proposal: Construction of replacement greenhouse

Decision: Remain neutral – leave to Planning Officer

Location: Northfield Lodge, Langton Road, Langton Green, Royal Tunbridge Wells Proposal: Single residential detached dwelling on land adjoining Northfield Lodge (building works commenced)
