Minutes of the Air Traffic Committee Meeting held in The Council Office, Langton Green Recreation Ground on Monday 13<sup>th</sup> February 2017 at 11.00am

- 1. To enquire if anyone present intends to film, photograph and/or record the meeting: No-one present intended to film, photograph and/or record the meeting.
- 2. To receive and approve apologies and reason for absence: None were received
- 3. Disclosure of Pecuniary or Non-Pecuniary Interests: There were none.
- **4. Declarations of Lobbying**: There were none.
- **5. Minutes:** It was **RESOLVED** that the minutes of the meeting dated **28**<sup>th</sup> **December 2016**, copies having previously been forwarded to Members, be approved and signed as a correct record.

- 7. Matters Arising and Correspondence: There was none
- **8.** A brief review of 31<sup>st</sup> January Noise Management Board Meeting: There was general agreement that the meeting had made some headway and Mr Howden was reasonably confident that the new GAL members would maintain progress.
- 9. Consideration of DfT Night Flight Consultation: There was general criticism of the document which was littered with inaccuracies, an example was the stated number of people affected (4,300) was well below a reasonable figure. It was agreed that it was unacceptable that unmodified aircraft are allowed to fly at night. Cllr Barrington-Johnson had circulated a draft response and there were a number of additional suggestions including a reference to air pollution to be included. Cllr Barrington-Johnson said he would respond to the consultation on-

line with the amendments included and would circulate a hard copy. Cllr Mrs Soyke thanked him for his efforts.

- 10. To consider other DfT Consultations: It was suggested that there will be a number of consultations this year, for example a Noise Consultation. Mr Howden produced a copy of DfT's UK Airspace Policy which had not been seen by the committee or HWCAAG. Cllr Barrington-Johnson will advise HWCAAG accordingly.
- **11. Items for information:** Mr Robinson asked if KCC would be responding to the consultation.
