## TW/11/00932/HOUSE

Location: Heathgate Cottage, Langton Road, Langton Green, Royal Tunbridge Wells Proposal: Relocation of existing vehicular access and installation of acoustic fencing

Decision: Recommend refusal

Comments:

The fence height appears excessive and out of keeping with the area - the majority of neighbouring fences and hedges are 2m or less.

No details or plans are provided regarding the return lengths of fencing along the boundaries with the neighbouring properties or the pedestrian access.

No details are provided regarding the effect of the proposals on existing trees or hedges. Each and every one of the above reasons is deemed sufficient to make the application unacceptable and to recommend refusal.

No objection in principle to the relocation of the vehicular access but please note that the septic tank which is shared with the neighbour is in the immediate vicinity and must be protected from the risk of any damage.

Location: Larkins, Furzefield Avenue, Speldhurst, Royal Tunbridge Wells

Proposal: Rear orangery extension

Decision: Remain neutral - leave to Planning Officer
