

## **Speldhurst Parish Council Environment Policy 2023**

The Council will support the long-term environmental, cultural and economic health and vitality of the Parish.

It will promote a high quality environment in the Parish and communities that are vibrant, safe, healthy and inclusive.

In its administration and activities it will seek to protect and enhance:

- 1. The special landscape quality of the Parish and access to the countryside;
- 2. The quality of the built environment and heritage features;
- 3. Biodiversity including habitats and protected species;
- 4. Village services and local employment opportunities;
- 5. Valued green spaces within villages, including village greens, and opportunities for recreation including sports and children's play;
- 6. The character, identity and rural setting of villages and hamlets;

## In addition the Council will:

- 7. Seek to conserve resources where practicable;
- 8. Aim to reduce soil, water, air, light and noise pollution, littering and fly-tipping;
- 9. Promote non-motorised transport;
- 10. Raise the profile of environmental issues, within the Parish and Borough
- 11. Encourage volunteering and the reporting of environmental issues;
- 12. Engage with local environmental agencies
- 13. Maintain an Environment Working Group (EWG) to monitor implementation of this policy and bring forward environmental initiatives.
