Note from the Clerk – regarding `non-severance` clause. The Clerk had contacted TWBC`s planners and was informed that this wording is very relevant and when appropriate we should continue to include in our responses.

`providing it remains incidental to the enjoyment of the dwelling house`, or

`use of the building hereby permitted shall be ancillary to the use of (address of property) and shall not be occupied or used separately from that dwelling`.
